

We believe that Music plays a vital part in the education of our pupils at STA, giving them a lifelong love and appreciation of music.

STA children receive an hour of music a week based on the new National Curriculum objectives of listening, improvising, composing and performing. Lessons are tied to the topics children cover through the International Primary Curriculum.



Children in Years 3 - 6 have the opportunity to learn an instrument and we have instrumental tutors who visit every week to provide a variety of instruments from guitar, woodwind, brass, recorder, steel pans to violin. We run 2 school bands for children in Years 5 and 6. Children come together every week for singing assembly, as well as 2 choirs for KS1 and 2. In addition, we also host the Hackney Bateria attended by children from across the borough.



We are very proud of the talented and inspirational musicians of the London Symphony Orchestra who have worked with our music teacher on a special project about classical music. Children in Year 4 have learnt about and played music by Tchaikovsky, Rimsky-Korsakov and many other classical composers.
