

## This is how we keep safe online

- We are online digital learners —we use the school's internet and devices for schoolwork, homework and other activities to learn and have fun. We only use sites, games and apps that trusted adults say we can.
- We are secure online learners we keep passwords to ourselves and reset them if anyone finds them out.
- We are careful online we think before we click on links and only download
  when we know it is safe or has been agreed by trusted adults. We
  understand that some people might not be who they say they are, so we
  should be very careful when someone wants to be our friend.
- We are private online We do not give out private information unless a
  trusted adult says it's okay. This includes our home address, phone number,
  school or other personal information that could be used to identify us or
  our family and friends.
- We keep our bodies to ourselves online we never change what we wear
  in front of a camera and remember that our body is ours and ours only, and
  we don't send any photos without checking with a trusted adult.
- We say no online if we need to if we get asked something that makes us worried or upset or just confused, we say no, stop chatting and tell a trusted adult.
- We are rule-followers online we know that some websites and social networks have age restrictions and we respect this; we only visit sites, games and apps that our trusted adults have agreed to.
- We are considerate online we do not join in with bullying or sharing inappropriate material.

- We are respectful online we do not post, make or share unkind, hurtful
  or rude messages/comments and tell our trusted adults if we see these.
- We are part of a community we do not make fun of anyone or exclude them because they are different to us. If we see anyone doing this, we tell a trusted adult.
- We are responsible online we keep others safe by talking to our trusted adults if a friend or person we know is being bullied or harassed or is worried or upset by things they read, watch or hear.
- We don't do public live streams on our own and only go on a video chat
  if our trusted adult knows we are doing it and who with.
- We communicate and collaborate online only with people we know and have met in real life or that a trusted adult knows about.
- We are SMART online We understand that unless we have met people in real life, we can't be sure who someone is online. We will never arrange to meet someone online. If someone would like to meet, we must ask a trusted adult for advice.
- We are creative digital learners online we don't just spend time online to
  look at things from other people; we get creative to learn and make things!
   We only edit or delete our own digital work and only use other people's
  with their permission or where it is copyright free or has a Creative
  Commons licence.
- We are a researcher online we use safer search tools approved by our trusted adults. We understand that not everything online can be believed, but we know how to check things and know to 'double check' information we find online.
